IB testing is complete

- 1) There are still some issues with NFSRDMA according to UNH-IOL Rupert has found out the problem with the help of with the NFS community and passed on the solution for UNH-IOL to resolve.
- 2) RSockets they are not sure of the status Rupert has found out the problem with the help of Sean and passed it on to UNH-IOL on 4/2/2015
- 3) Reports are not what will go on Website but are the first drafts and subject to arbitration.
 - a) If test plan shows signs of failure, then they call the device a failed. But if test plan or OFED is the basis they will
 - b) **Arbitration**: two weeks for vendor and two weeks for IWG to resolve.

RoCE - Dave

- 1) Still some issues with things hanging and not working.
- 2) He will send out reports.
- 3) They have tried 15 different daily builds or RCs
- 4) Debug event is coming up and so they need to focus on that.
- 5) Bob has asked us to stop and just report. Vendors have said they don't have drivers to support RC1. There are still vendors trying to resolve issues.
- 6) Bob cannot restart process with another build. He feels we need to move on and do RoCE Logo List in June with 3.18 GA.
- 7) Bob encourages vendors on site for debugging. He wants to need Logo Process for RoCE. By moving on it allows us to open up the cluster for debugging
- 8) Pradeep supports the idea of moving on and not producing OFA Logo List.
- 9) Bill are we testing V1 or V2
 - a) V1 but there are some features that required
 - b) Agenda item
 - i) libfabric
 - ii) Soft RoCE
 - iii) Soft iWARP
 - c) IBM and Bernard.
- 10) Pradeep
 - a) OFED 3.18 GA we should not proceed
 - b) Wants to wait for Interop Debug
- 11) Bob Reports all ready to go. Please respond ASAP. Once reports are signed off then we go live. Wants to get this done before April Interop debug event.
